Innovative elements present in the proposal have to be taken into account.</i></p> <p>Milestone, Budget, and Resources <i>Please evaluate the overall process followed, milestones and resources of the proposed project, cost justification, and the availability of resources needed. Relevant here is also the tradeoff between what the proposal promises to achieve and the feasibility given its requested budget. The panel can either reject the proposal, accept it as it is, or accept conditionally to changes to the amount requested.</i></p>	<p>/5 (Threshold 3, weight 2)</p>
<p>Evaluation and Feedback (weight x1)</p> <p>Evaluation of the developed tools, data sources, and approaches <i>Please, evaluate the capacity of the participants to assess their solution, taking into account domains, duration, and methodology soundness.</i></p> <p>Quality and quantity of evaluation data <i>Please, evaluate the quality of the assessment data and the amount of evidence produced (either against or in favor of the proposed solution)</i></p> <p>Feedback about the OpenReq existing features to the consortium <i>Please, evaluate the participant potential to provide feedback about existing</i></p>	<p>/5 (Threshold 3, weight 1)</p>
